## How to Participate?

1. Contact your local SWEPCO energy advisor to receive a CoolSaver contractor agreement form and contractor manual.
  2. Complete the contractor agreement form and submit along with all required documentation to your local SWEPCO advisor.
  3. Purchase the required toolkit and sign up to attend the required CoolSaver training class.
  4. Once a contractor has successfully passed the training course they will be given a Technician Qualification number and will be able to start completing tune-ups.
  5. Once a tune-up has been completed, the contractor will apply an instant discount on the customers invoice and then submit the required tune-up data and documentation.
  6. Once the tune-up data has been reviewed and accepted, the contractor will receive the incentive payment for the completed tune-up.
